### **Cateforis to receive Kansas Bar Association service award**

KU Law School's Elizabeth Cateforis has been selected to receive an Outstanding Service Award by the Kansas Bar Association.

The KBA Continuing Education Committee nominated Cateforis for the award in recognition of her work on the fourth edition of the Kansas Criminal Law Handbook.

The six recipients of the 2007 Outstanding Service Award will be honored at the KBA annual meeting on June 9 in Wichita.

Cateforis has been a supervising attorney in the Paul E. Wilson Defender Project since 1999. Prior to joining the faculty, she was an assistant appellate defender at the Kansas Appellate Defender Office for the five years following her graduation from law school. She is a 1994 graduate of the KU Law School.

KBA Outstanding Service Awards are given to recognize lawyers and judges for service to the legal profession or the KBA and to recognize non-lawyers for especially meritorious deeds or service that significantly advance the administration of justice or the goals of the legal profession. No more than six Outstanding Service Awards may be given in one year.
